# C Harmonic Minor Scale

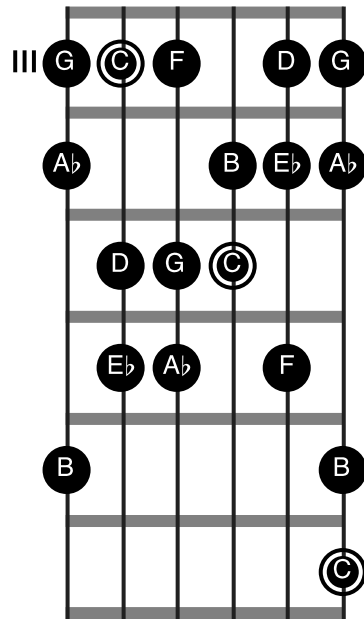

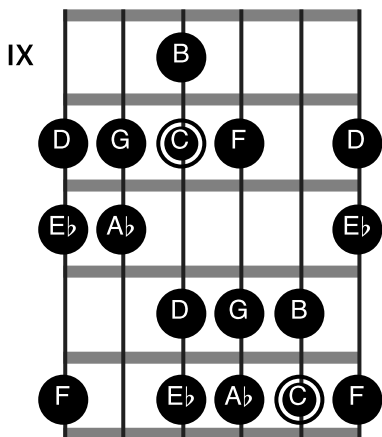

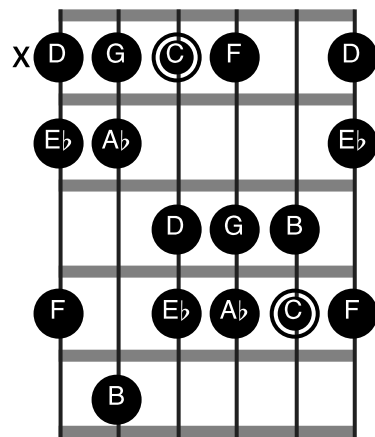
The D Shape alternate fingering uses the B on the 5th String rather than B on the 4th string.
